The responsibility of Relationships Australia Tasmania staff

Our staff will:

- Do our best to make sure that you are safe from harm
- Supervise you while you are in our program
- Ask your parents or guardians permission in writing before we transport you
- Ask your parents or guardian permission before we take photographs of you
- Not babysit you, visit you at home or give you gifts
- Not call, text, email or contact you on social media
- Give you guidance that is fair, respectful, and appropriate to your age and background
- Help you and other children if you feel unsafe, uncomfortable, or upset.

The responsibility of children

When you take part in our programs you have to behave positively by:

- Telling staff or a parent if you feel unsafe, upset, or uncomfortable
- Treating other children and adults with respect
- Following the rules of the program
- · Listening to others and being kind
- Asking staff if you feel you need to leave the program
